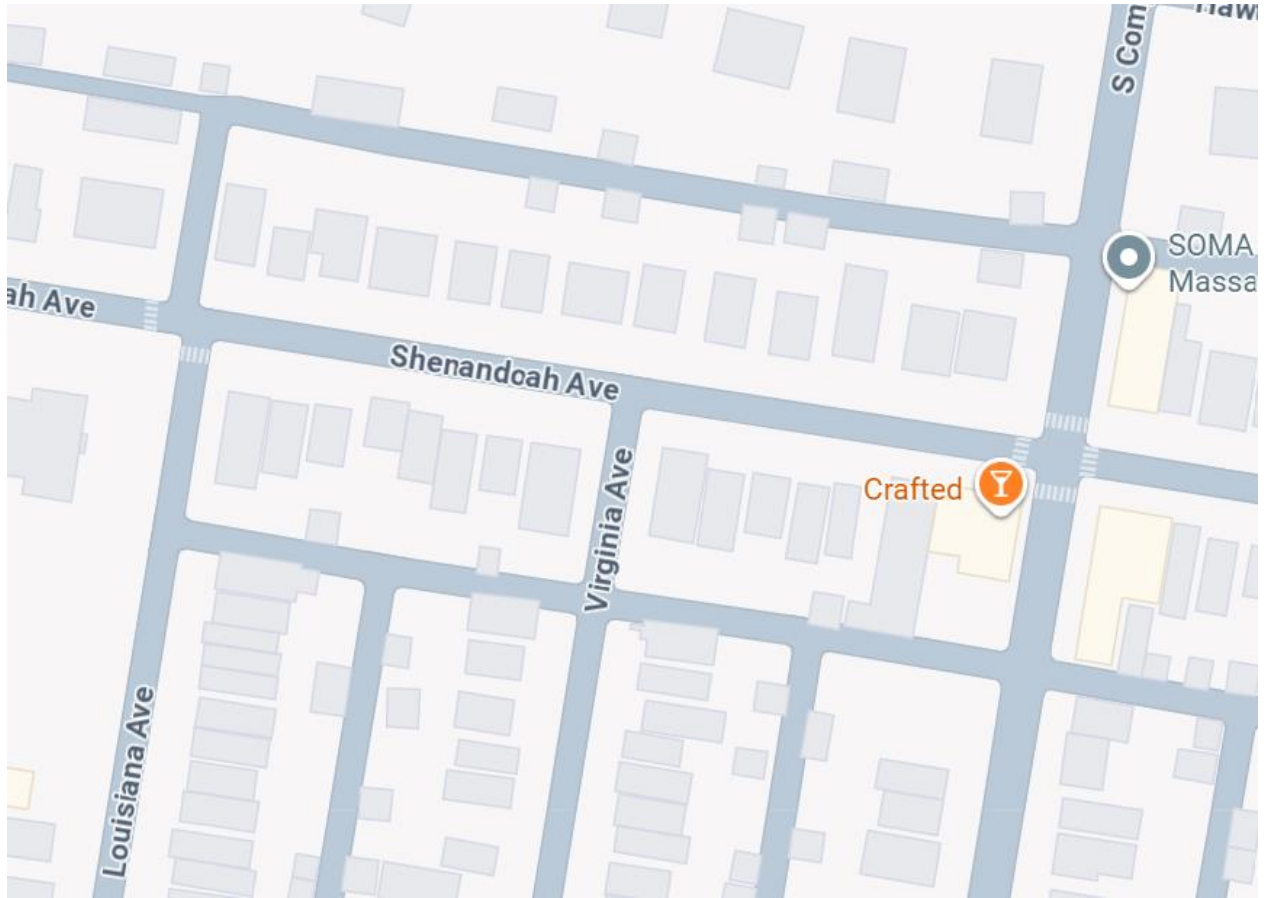
4 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS AS FOLLOWS:**

5 **SECTION ONE.** There is hereby established a three-way stop site at the intersection of  
6 Shenandoah Avenue and Virginia Avenue regulating all traffic traveling in all directions at the  
7 intersection of Shenandoah Avenue and Virginia Avenue. The Director of Streets is hereby  
8 authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location to regulate traffic approaching this  
9 intersection.

10 **SECTION TWO. Emergency Clause.** This being an Ordinance for the preservation of public  
11 peace, health, and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure within the meaning of  
12 Sections 19 and 20 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of St. Louis and therefore this Ordinance  
13 shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

7 on various blocks in the 9th ward as follows:

- 8 1. Speed Humps shall be installed on the 3900-4000 Block of West Pine Blvd
- 9 2. Speed Humps shall be installed on the 3900-4000 Block of Laclede Avenue
