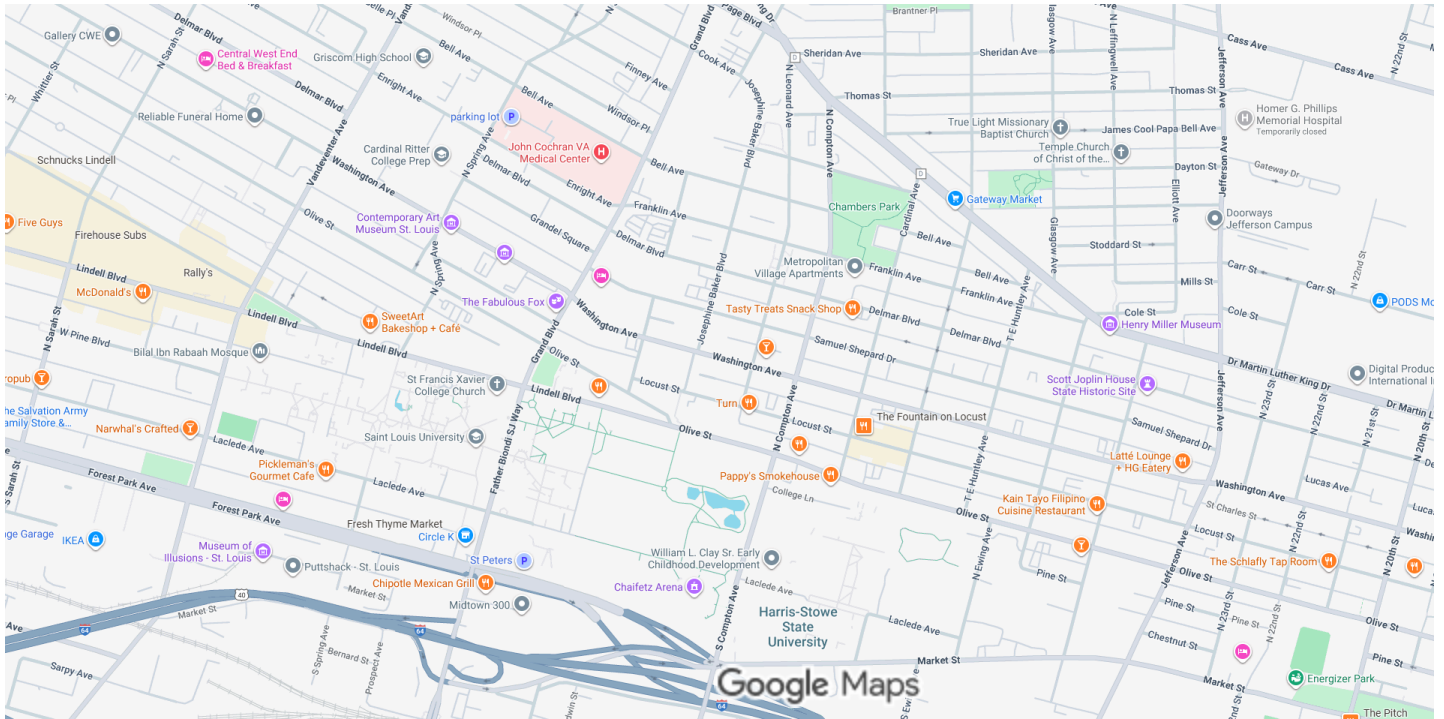

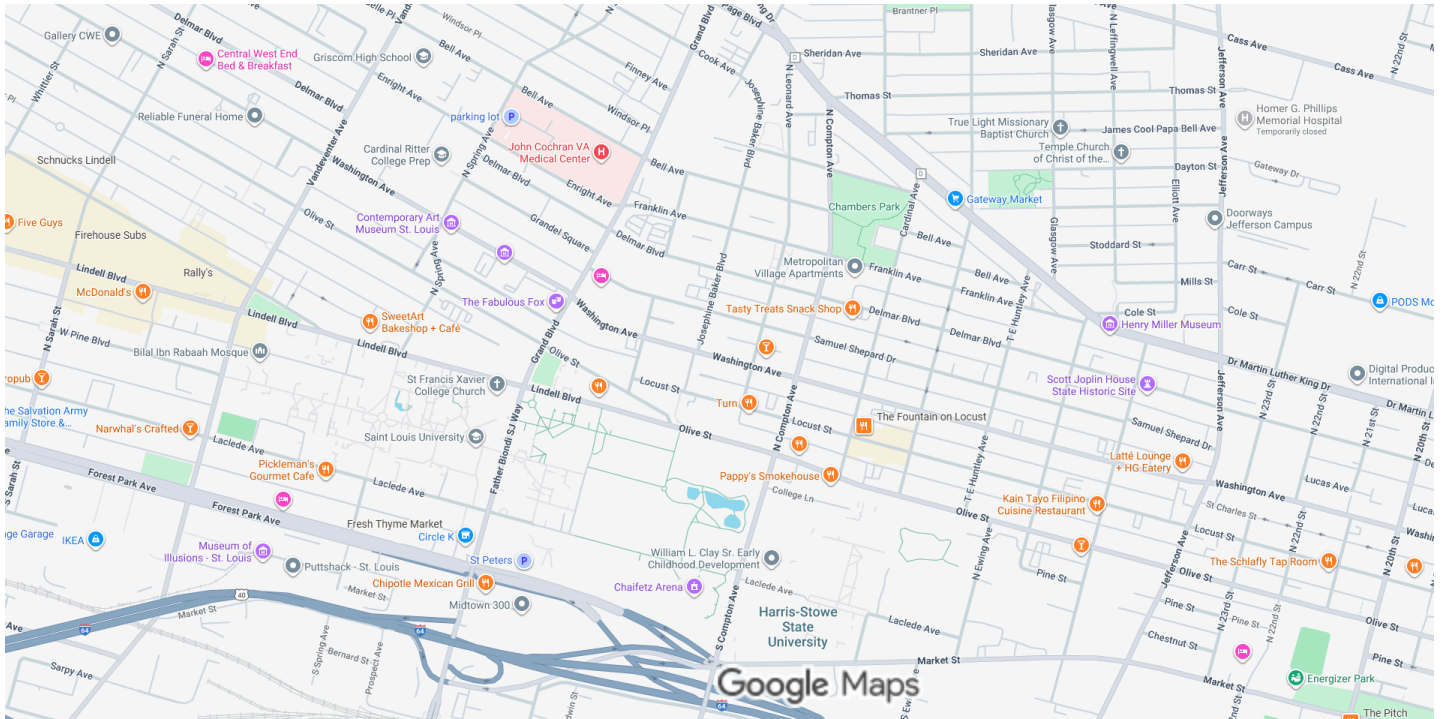
Board Bill Number 81 Map: 3600 and 3700 Blocks of Grandel Square
