Pursuant to **Ordinance Number 70333** as amended by **Ordinance Number 71394**, an ordinance directing the Director of Streets to install speed humps to calm the flow of traffic in the first ward.

WHEREAS, the Office of the 1st Ward has developed a procedure for requesting speed control which includes the use of a citizen petition; and

WHEREAS, a total of 10 residents of the 10 occupied dwellings signed on in support of the installation of speed humps constituting an overwhelming majority.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF ST. LOUIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. Pursuant to **Ordinance Number 70333** as amended by **Ordinance Number 71394** the Director of Streets is hereby directed to install speed humps to calm the flow of traffic at the following location(s) in the first ward.
