Item Number 1

Board Bill Number 32

Introduced by Alderman Matt Devoti

Pursuant to Ordinance Number 70333 as amended by Ordinance Number 71394, an ordinance directing the Director of Streets to install speed humps to calm the flow of traffic on various blocks in the 5th ward.

Mr. Devoti expressed a desire to install a speed hump on Edwards Street, which experiences significant commercial traffic and has been requested by the residents.

Item Number 2

Board Bill Number 34

Introduced by Alderwoman Laura Keys

An ordinance directing the Director of Streets to install speed humps pursuant to Ordinance Number 70333 as amended by Ordinance Number 71394 to calm the flow of traffic on the 3600, 3700, 3800, 3900, 4000, 4100, 4200, 4300, 4400, 4500, 4600, 4700 and 4800 blocks of Lee Avenue.

Board Bill Number 38

Introduced by Aldermen Michael Browning

An ordinance recommended by the Board of Public Service authorizing the 2025 St. Louis Works and the 50/50 Sidewalk Programs City Wide providing for the construction and reconstruction of gutters, streets, driveways, spot curbs, sidewalks, alleys, traffic controls, beautification, tree planting, resurfacing and related engineering adjustments listed herein, appropriating \$5,600,000.00 from the Street Improvement Fund; containing sections for description of the work, approval of plans and specifications, work and material guarantees, estimated costs from City funds and supplemental agreements and reversion authorizations, applicable state and federal wage rate requirements, equal opportunity provisions, the Mayor's Executive Orders, contract advertising statutes, and a public work emergency clause.

The Chair handed the meeting over to the Vice-Chair so he could bring forth Board Bill Number 38.

Mr. Browning provided an overview of Saint Louis works and stated he had Kent Flakes, Street Commissioner, who would be available to answer any questions.
