Board Bill Number 93

An ordinance, recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, appropriating the sum of Three Million Three Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Five and 05/100ths (\$3,365,535.05) of Rams Settlement Funds, for the purpose of supporting winter shelter needs for unhoused residents; authorizing and directing the Director of the Department of Human Services ("DHS") to execute contracts as may be necessary to

This Board Bill recommended by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment, appropriating the sum of Nine Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand and 0/100ths (\$9,350,000.00) Dollars of one-time unreserved General Operating Reserve funds for deposit into the Tornado Relief and Recovery Fund, for the purpose of supporting winter-related emergency shelter and additional tornado disaster relief to support housing of residents impacted by the May 16, 2025, tornado. It has a severability clause and an emergency clause.
